FAMILY RIGHTS POLICY

Positive Family will ensure that the family’s rights as listed below are protected in accordance with federal and state requirements:

- The right to services that respect your personal liberty, culture, ethnicity, race, gender, age, religion, sexual orientation, language, values and customs.
- The right to an individualized, written family goal plan to be developed by you with the help of your Family Support Specialist, within the first 45 days after you accepted services. This plan is reviewed periodically and revisions are made as your circumstances change.
- The right to refuse services. The Positive Family offers services on a voluntary basis. If you do not wish to receive home visiting services, you do not have to.
- The right to insure confidentiality of your records.
- The right to access, upon request, your records.
- The right to be referred to other services as needed and requested.
